- Monday, February 5 J.H. Rose High School will host a Curriculum Fair for rising 9th grade students from 6:00-8:00. This event is a floating event. This event is **not** mandatory but is recommended.
- Thursday, February 8 Aycock Middle School will be hosting a parent night at 6:00 pm. Counselors from J.H. Rose High School will be present to answer any questions that you may have about the registration process. This event is **not** mandatory but is recommended especially for clarifications or questions in regards to the registration process and/or course selection.
- **Teacher Recommendations** Teacher recommendations will be entered into Powerschool and are able to be seen by parents and students. Teacher recommendations are highly suggested, but are **not** a requirement.
- Monday, February 19 The student portal for registration will open. Students are encouraged to register with their parents online before March 2, 2018. Students will need to use their Powerschool login and password in order to register for courses.
- Friday, March 2 Powerschool "at home" registration will close. Parents and students must have their course selections entered into Powerschool by this date.
- Counselor Conferences Mrs. Simmons and Mrs. Eblin will be conferencing with students in regards to their high school registration course selections. Conferences will take place during the week of March 6th-9th.
- Verification Forms Verification forms will be sent home with students once they have completed their conference with a counselor. If changes need to be made, parents must make the change on this form, sign the form, and return the form by March 16th.
