- Will this course hold my interest?
- Am I ready for this challenge?
- Does this course move me toward my goal?
- What is required of me in this course?

Your three alternative electives will be used to accommodate conflicts and full classes during scheduling.

# Final Course Registration

After registration activities are complete and you and your parent/guardian have made decisions about your selections, you will register your course requests for next year in PowerSchool.

- Click the submit button to save your selections! Your counselor will review your selections.
- A course review sheet will be sent home for parental review and corrections.
